## BODYBUILDERS HOUSEPARTY:

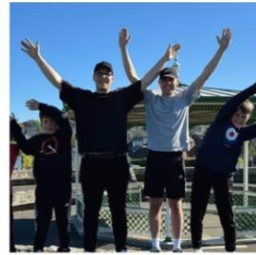
